Gage Facial Moisturizer for Men

GAGE Facial Moisturizer has been formulated for men to reduce fine lines and wrinkles, counter the buildup of free radical cells that accumulate over time, and help keep the complexion healthy.

TARGETS: Fine lines, wrinkles, dryness, acne, blemishes, uneven skin tone.

BENEFITS: Smoother skin, improved skin tone, less wrinkles, less blemishes, protection against free radical cells.

HOW TO USE: After washing, apply GAGE over clean, damp face. The moisture will bond with the hyaluronic acid in GAGE to hydrate the skin. Ideally, use GAGE Facial Moisturizer after GAGE Serum to lock in nutrients. A serum and a moisturizer go hand-in-hand, the serum penetrating to the deeper layers of skin to effectively hydrate, promote new collagen production, and reduce inflammation, and the moisturizer working on the top layers to reduce fine lines and wrinkles, improve skin elasticity, and protect the skin from external factors including sun, smoke, and pollution.

A little goes a long way. Adjust the amount you use according to how dry your skin is and how often you wash your face.

INGREDIENTS:

Hyaluronic Acid is a popular skincare ingredient because of its ability to hold up to 1000 times its weight in water. GAGE contains



low molecular weight (fragmented) hyaluronic acid that penetrates more deeply, carrying other nutrients with it.

Argan Oil from Morocco is one of skin care's finest oils, rich in vitamin E and essential fatty acids, yet with a comedogenic score of zero, meaning it will absolutely not clog pores.

Organic Coconut Oil is an ultra-moisturizing oil high in lauric acid, with antimicrobial properties effective against skin bacteria known to cause acne and breakouts.

Palmitoyl TriPeptide-38 is a synthesis of six peptides that promote collagen production and skin healing which help smooth out skin by reducing fine lines and wrinkles and pushing oils and spent cells out of clogged pores.

Vitamin E is a time-honored agent for collagen production and skin healing.

CBD is a powerful antioxidant, anti-inflammatory, and antimicrobial whose many benefits to the skin are still being discovered. Its ability to reduce inflammation and combat free radical cells are well documented. More recently, CBD has been shown to moderate the production of sebum from the skin's sebaceous glands, which helps reduce the excess oil and inflammation that may lead to acne.
